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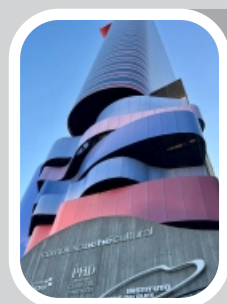

Cristina Salgado: The Mother Gazes at the Sea - The Rio-born artist brings to the central space of Pina Luz, the Octagon, a monumental installation that explores the symbolic relationship between the female body and the sea through dozens of suspended strips of richly coloured carpet.

Pascale Marthine Tayou: Knockout! - The first institutional exhibition in Brazil dedicated to Cameroonian artist Pascale Marthine Tayou brings together installations, sculptures, and paintings spanning more than twenty-five years of his career.

Using everyday materials transformed through unexpected combinations, Tayou invites visitors to reflect on exchange, coexistence, and collective life.

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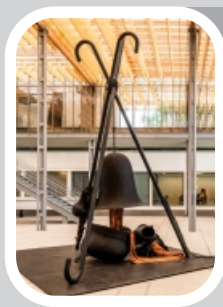
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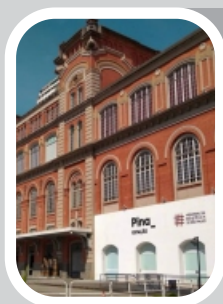

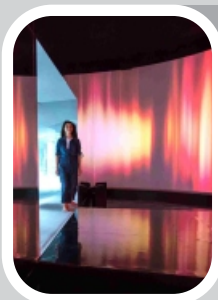
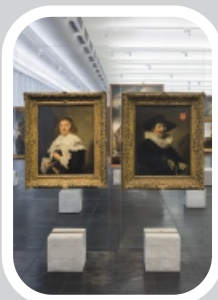
One of Latin America's most influential political art collectives, the Chilean group CADA carried out a series of public interventions between 1979 and 1985 in direct response to the Pinochet dictatorship. Through photographs, documents, videos, and archival materials, the exhibition revisits these groundbreaking actions, demonstrating how art can become a powerful instrument of democratic resistance.

La Chola Poblete: Andean Pop

La Chola Poblete adopts the term *chola* as both identity and subject of investigation, reclaiming a racial slur directed at her indigenous heritage. Working across drawing and performance, the Argentine artist deconstructs colonial stereotypes through visual appropriations and mixtures that, in this exhibition, extend all the way to the walls.

Claudia Alarcón & Silät: Living by Weaving

Formed by more than one hundred women from the Wichí people (Salta, Argentina), the collective Claudia Alarcón & Silät renews the ancestral tradition of weaving. Their works come to life through the *chaguar*, an indigenous bromeliad with strong and resilient fibers.

The Frevo Bixiga Orchestra is one of the rare São Paulo orchestras dedicated to frevo. Made up of 13 musicians and one passista (step dancer), the group celebrates frevo in São Paulo with their debut show "Olha o frevo!" featuring classics by great masters such as José Menezes, Duda and Zacarias, through to the frevo-jazz of Maestro Spok. Since 2023, the orchestra has shared the stage with several artists from Pernambuco, including Maestro Spok at the first edition of his block Jornada nas Estrelas; composer and arranger Alexandre Rodrigues, singer Laís Senna, and multi-artist Angelo Madureira, as well as São Paulo singer Paula Sanches.



JULY 18 - SAMBA DA PEDRA DO SAL

Born at the foot of Morro da Conceição, a place of vast historical and religious symbolism that became known as the "Salt Stone," in the city where the largest slave market on the planet was located, Cais do Valongo, the Roda de Samba da Pedra do Sal has established itself as one of the most expressive samba circles in Rio de Janeiro. Since 2007, Mondays have been more joyful in that area.

Energetic, syncopated, and highly dance-inviting musical sets led by wind instruments, featuring danceable arrangements of great classics woven together with saintly mambos, moving through styles such as danzón, son cubano, mambo, cha-cha-cha, merecumbé, salsa and bolero.

Firma o Ponto – Samba de Terreiro presents a repertoire of African-rooted chants in reference to the orixás, enchanted beings, and spirits of light, with songs that propose an intersection of languages, blending traditional Candomblé rhythms with Brazilian samba. Atabaques, congas, and ilús drive the circle and the reclaiming of the Afrocentric ancestry and musicality proposed by the group. Firma o Ponto also performs works by Martinho da Vila, Jorge Aragão, Clara Nunes, Ruy Maurity, Os Tincões, and other important Brazilian samba artists.

**JULY 22 - Mateus Gonsales / 2nd Piano & Its Creatures Showcase****CASA DE FRANCISCA - 9:30pm**

Mateus Gonsales, a pianist-composer from Paraná known for leading trios and expressive projects such as the album Alquimia, performs today in his purest and most intimate form, exploring the challenging yet expansive sound of **Piano Solo**. He brings to the stage an original repertoire featuring works by important composers of Brazilian instrumental music. He will also be joined by special guest singer Marina Marchi, bringing her contemporary and jazz-influenced approach.

Pelados play independent rock with total creative freedom. Going against the grain of ready-made formulas, they record their own records and blend references from classic indie with contemporary experimentation.

Welcome to São Paulo!

The easiest and most efficient ways to get around the city are by using ride-hailing apps (such as Uber) and São Paulo's extensive public transport network. To help you travel around the city during the Meeting, we've put together a few practical tips.

We recommend using Google Maps or the Moovit app to plan your journeys in real time.



METRO AND CPTM (TRAINS)

São Paulo's metro and commuter rail system forms the backbone of the city's public transport network. Fast, reliable, and fully integrated, it connects most of the city's main neighbourhoods and attractions.

Lines: They are identified by colors and numbers. **Lines 1-Blue, 2-Green** (which runs along Av. Paulista), and **4-Yellow** are the most used by visitors going to the city center and west zone.

Integration: You can switch between metro and train lines (CPTM) at transfer stations without paying an additional fare.



BUSES (SPTRANS)

São Paulo's bus fleet is huge and includes dedicated bus lanes, which help avoid traffic during peak hours.

How to navigate: Using apps like Google Maps or Moovit is essential. They show the exact bus line number, estimated arrival time, and where to get off.



PRACTICAL PAYMENT TIPS

How to pay for transport:

Pix or credit/debit card: At metro and CPTM turnstiles, you can tap your physical card, phone, or smartwatch. You can also buy digital QR tickets via Pix using the official TOP app.

Cash: Buses do not accept credit/debit cards at the turnstile, only cash or the local transport card (Bilhete Único). If you use buses, always carry small bills and coins.

EXTRA TIPS

Avoid rush hours (7–9am and 5–7:30pm), when stations and buses are very crowded.

Keep your bag in front of your body and pockets secured at all times.
